

Watercolor Workshop Supply List

Watercolor Paints (pans or tubes)

Set of at least 12 colors

Suggested colors: Cobalt Blue, Indigo Blue, Alizarin crimson, Hookers Green Deep, Yellow Ochre, Lemon Yellow, Cadmium-Free Yellow, Raw Sienna, Burnt Sienna, Turquoise, Burnt Umber, Neutral Tint or Payne's Gray

White Guache – This is a water-based paint that is opaque, unlike most watercolor pigments which are transparent.

Watercolor Paper:

140 lb., cold-pressed, 9" X 12" or 11" X 14"

2 water cups, one for rinsing and one for wetting

Masking tape

Cardboard or foam board larger than your watercolor paper

White plastic or ceramic palette

Brushes

- No. 4 round
- No. 6 round
- No. 10 round
- No. 6 flat
- No. 10 flat
- Liner brush

(No. 6 round, No. 6 flat, and No. 10 round are enough to start with.)

Paper towels or tissues

#2B pencil and soft eraser, such as art gum

Masking fluid

Small natural sponges
